


1. What is your current class standing at UCSC?









5. The instructor used course time effectively to support my learning.







The instructor helped me feel engaged frequently by creating assignments in class to get us to participate





While the instructor was open to emailing any information you may need about the course, it would be more equitable for working students and introverted students to post a syllabus with all of the expected due dates on Canvas, as well as post feedback on the class exercises on which questions were missed. A syllabus with expected due dates helps working students manage their time better because many working students may need to complete assignments several days ahead of the due date, and thus need a lot of notice. Without the feedback, the class exercises felt like a quiz and it adds more unnecessary stress and frustration. Providing feedback helps students learn the material and how the material is graded.
I was unsure if learning how to use stata was a goal. We were provided a lot of answers that made assignments a lot easier. I wasn't challenged the Stata aspect of the class, but I'm not sure if that was a goal.
